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## CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE IN COFFEE QUALITY AND TRADE (CQT) TO BE OFFERED IN COLLABORATION BETWEEN MOSHI CO-OPERATIVE UNIVERSITY (MoCU) AND TANZANIA COFFEE BOARD (TCB) FOR 2015/2016 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Moshi Co-operative University (MoCU) the then Moshi University College of Co-operative and Business Studies (MUCCoBS) in collaboration with the Tanzania Coffee Board (TCB) are pleased to announce the commencement of the new programme certificate of **Coffee Quality and Trade (CQT)**. This is a practical oriented programme that is expected to be offered in collaboration of MoCU and TCB for the purpose of equipping candidates with the highly needed knowledge and skills in coffee quality, liquoring and trading. The graduates in this course are expected to work in different areas of the coffee industry such as liquoring, warehousing, coffee curing, wet mills, roasting and general trading. As well as providing them with wide knowledge and skills on the value chain including entrepreneurship, coffee business management, co-operatives and farmer associations.

Application for admission are invited from qualified individuals (Tanzanians and non-Tanzanians) wishing to pursue the certificate programme in Coffee Quality and Trade (CQT) for the academic year 2015/2016. The programme will commence on 3rd November 2014 to run for one year (two semesters) starting from November 2015. Each semester shall have a total of 15 weeks.

### 2.0 Minimum Entry Requirements:

An applicant must have the following qualifications for admission under this programme:

- i. Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum of four D's in either of the following subjects; English, Book Keeping, Commerce, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Agriculture and Biology. OR
- ii. Advanced Certificate of Secondary School Education (ACSSE) with at least two passes in either of the following subjects: Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Agriculture, Economics, Nutrition and Biology. The total points from the principal level pass should not be less than 2.0. OR
- iii. Graduate from recognized high learning institutes and practitioner in coffee sector will get preference.

### 3.0 Mode of Application

The application must be accompanied by:

- (a) A bank pay-in-slip or receipt of non-refundable fee of Tanzanian shillings Thirty thousand (Tshs. 30,000/=) for Tanzanian nationals payable to Moshi Co-operative University through Account No. 01J/2036991800 CRDB BANK-MOSHI BRANCH. (ACCOUNT NAME: MUCCoBS STUDENTS' FEE ACCOUNT). Or thirty US dollars (30 US Dollars) for foreigners payable to MUCCoBS dollar ACCOUNT NO.02J1038874400.
- (b) Certified photocopies of relevant academic certificates/transcripts.
